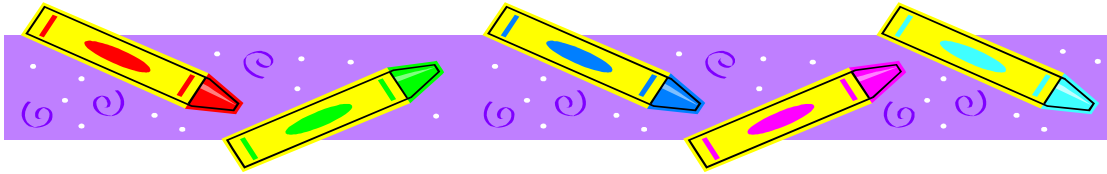

Meal Magic News

From business manager, Mike McLaughlin After evaluation of resources and data input needed for the system, the implementation of the Meal Magic Point of Sale Cafeteria product will begin school wide on Monday, May 14, 2012. As communicated earlier, we recommend and encourage pre-payment (weekly, monthly, etc.) for student accounts. You may begin to use the pre-payment form prior to the system start. These funds will be credited to your student as we have done in the past and the carryover balance will be maintained in Meal Magic beginning May 14.

Is your student familiar with their 4 or 5 digit student ID number? The student number can be referenced on Grade Cards for students in Grades 1-12. *ECC families will have their student numbers communicated to them.* Students in grades 4-12 will be entering their student numbers via a keypad set up at the register. *Data input for Pre-School through Grade 3 lunches will be input by the Cafeteria Staff.*
